HCAFA-HARPER RELATIONSHIP TEAM



HCAFA recognizes that it is to adjuncts' advantage to utilize all possible methods of resolving problems that arise. Although we have had to resort to the grievance procedure numerous times, we'd prefer to save that procedure for those issues that can not be resolved amicably. Consequently, HCAFA and the administration have formed a relationship team. The team meets on a regular basis to discuss areas of concern that we feel can be resolved through dialogue and not necessitate the grievance procedure.

As a result of our last meeting,

- The college has attached both the large lecture pay memo of understanding and the newly-clarified professional development memo of understanding to the Adjunct Agreement. Both can be found by going on the Harper website (www.harpercollege.edu) to *My Harper*, then *Divisions*, then *HR/Diversity*, then *Employee Contracts*, then to *Adjunct Faculty Agreement*.
- The college has confirmed that even if an adjunct member tells the college that he/she does not plan to teach in the following semester(s), the adjunct is still covered under the maintenance of inclusion provision in our contract and will be given at least a three-credit-hour class if he/she has missed no more than 2 semesters (excluding summer). Mia Igyarto, HR Director, said that she will inform all Deans of the right of adjunct members to return if they have filled out their availability form in a timely manner.
- Availability forms for teaching will be put on line so that adjuncts may access them at their convenience.

LIBRARIANS AND COUNSELORS

Joanne Meyerhoff is taking the lead at organizing a meeting on campus just for adjunct librarians and counselors. Finding a time to meet has been a challenge; adjunct librarians and counselors often work at more than one place and at varying times. If you have not already heard from Joanne, you will hear from her shortly.

GRIEVANCE UPDATE

- Fair share grievance resolved.
- Arbitration regarding termination of employment cancelled due to adjunct's decision not to pursue arbitration.
- Arbitration regarding class assignment scheduled for June, 2010.
- Dual unit membership ULP (unfair labor practice) has been confirmed by the Illinois Labor Relations Board as a case with merit and is scheduled to be heard on January 28.

What Are My Weingarten Rights?

If you are ever in a situation that you believe could lead to any kind of disciplinary action, you have the right to have a union representative with you. In a situation like that, to protect yourself, say, "If this discussion could in any way lead to my being disciplined or terminated, or affect my personal working conditions, I respectfully request that my union representative be present at the meeting. Without representation, I choose not to answer any questions." Under no circumstances should you lose your cool or walk out of the meeting.

No More Printouts

Many of us trust that our paychecks are being deposited into our banks with the proper amounts. However, mistakes do get made, especially when there's subbing involved or dues deducted. It never hurts to check the amounts being deposited.

- To do that, go online to *Harpercollege.edu*.
- In the left column, click faculty/staff.
- In the faculty staff window that appears, under the words *faculty/staff*, click on *Employee Portal*.
- That will bring you to the employee portal.
- At the employee portal, type in your user name & password. (Need help, contact the help desk.) *Login*.
- In the left column, choose *Oracle e-Business Suite* for on campus or *Oracle e-Business Suite* for off campus depending on where you are.
- Again enter your user name and password. Login.
- At E-Business Suite, click on Employee Self Service.
- Click on *pay slip* in the next window to see your most recent pay slip. Click on the down arrow next to the most recent one to see all the deposits in your account.. Print any desired statements.

Dear Kat,

I want to be a member of HCAFA, but I didn't get my dues deducted from my payroll as I only taught the first 8 weeks of the semester. What should I do? Adjunct on the Fast Track

The easiest solution is to contact Janice Cutler, MS/Math--if she hasn't contacted you. You'll be able to pay dues by sending a check to HCAFA.

Check your pay! Make sure you are being paid according to the schedule in our contract. If you see a problem, contact the college for clarification. The payroll department has been very cooperative. (Refer to Kat's Korner, column 1 p. 2 for complete details on how to check your deposits on line.)

Fill out your availability sheet for the semester you want to return to teaching. If you do not teach for one or two semesters and then want to return to teach, it is your responsibility to get your availability sheet in to the Dean on time. It's important to be aware that in some divisions, availability forms must be handed in during the first

week of the semester preceding the semester you plan to teach. (See Relationship Team, column 1 p. 1.)
