Issue: School Funding

Sen. Bill Brady — Jason Plummer

- Oppose any increase in personal or corporate income tax
- Oppose "progressive" tax system based on ability to pay

Gov. Pat Quinn — Shelia Simon

- Support increasing state revenue through personal and corporate income tax

- Would bar collective bargaining and strikes
- Support reduction of Illinois' minimum wage
- Oppose law mandating equal pay for men and women

Quinn — Simon

- Fully support the Collective Bargaining Act
- Support Illinois' minimum wage at the current level
- Declared a Proclamation for Equal Pay Day; April 20, 2010
